Georgia ESF 12

ESF 12 in Georgia

- GEFA is the lead ESF 12 coordinator
- GEFA staffs the State Operations Center during any activation requiring ESF 12
- GEFA works closely with private sector energy partners



Hurricane Irma

- Impacted every county in the state
- Georgia hosted evacuees from Florida
- Georgia issued evacuation orders for the GA coast
- Over one million customers without power in GA at peak



Fuel Impacts in Georgia

- Fuel already tight due to Hurricane Harvey
- Fuel impacts felt most along:
 - I-75 between Florida and Atlanta
 - I-95 along Georgia coast
 - I-16 between Savannah and Macon
 - US Hwy 19



Fuel Impacts in Georgia

- Monitored data from Gas Buddy
- Fuel distribution was main challenge
 - Traffic and weather impacted deliveries
 - Overall, enough bulk fuel at terminals in GA
- Up to 50% of stations without fuel in some locations
 - Coastal communities along I-95 hardest hit
 - Even Atlanta had fuel outages



Actions Taken in Georgia

- Close coordination with private sector partners
 - Fuel coordination calls
- Driver hour waivers
- Weight restrictions lifted
- EPA waivers
- Fueled state-owned tanks
